GERMAN HOME COOKING DIRECT TO YOU

Organized under the Wyoming Food Freedom Act of 2015 as amended to date, GASTSTÄTTE JumpingSand prepares homemade food from a home kitchen. The purpose of this approach is to establish a visible presence in the local area's ever-fluctuating restaurant culture while keeping control of both quality and cost. Plans to open a brick-and-mortar restaurant will be openly pursued once a suitable location is presented and the timing is conducive. JumpingSand Ventures, Inc. has correctly registered with, is in compliance with, and is permitted by federal, state, and local government entities including employment and sales tax agencies.

On the debut menu are wonderful offerings from traditional Mennonite culture of old-world Germany as well as familiar contemporary treats of modern-day Germany. The emphasis is what would have been served in the Mennonite farm community traversing much of Germany prior to 1806, the Molotschna valley in Ukraine between 1806-1885, the Hillsboro, KS community after 1895, and modern-day Germany especially Stuttgart and the state of Baden-Württemberg. Some of the menu highlights are indicated below.

Various sauces accompanying thinly-pounded fried pork cutlet called Schnitzel are a welcome favorite of the menu to include:

- Jägerschnitzel: "Hunter" sauce made of mushrooms and red wine.
- Wienerschnitzel: Originally from the city of Vienna (Wien in German), garnished generously with parsley and lemon.
- Rahmschnitzel: Cream sauce

Other offerings include:

- Sauerbraten: a marinated, brined, and slow-roasted Roast Beef with traditional German spices of Juniper Berry, Allspice, Clove, Ginger, Cinamon, and other herbs and spices served in a tangy gravy.
- Frikadellen: "fried meatloaf patty", the tasty treat found on most every corner snack cart menu in Germany today.
- Fisch Eintopf: a thick brew of saucy vegetables accompanied by fillets of salmon and cod or similar.

Soups and Salads:

- Gemischter Salat: "Mixed Salad", a common "everything" kind of salad with pickled and fresh vegetables and a small lettuce portion served usually with a simple creamy yoghurt dressing
- Grüner Salat: "Green Salad", just your typical side salad, a little bit of chopped vegetables with a portion of lettuce
- Kartoffelsalat: "Potato Salad", Schwäbische style with a very simple "Haberschlachter Funf" oil and wine-vinegar dressing spiced with tarragon, salt and pepper.
- Gurkensalat: "Cucumber Salad", a common traditional recipe with dill, dill, and more dill. And oil and vinegar, salt and pepper. And slivered red onion. And more dill.
- Bauernmittel Suppe: "Farmers Soup", sausage and vegetables in a savory broth. The "everyday" soup.

Side Dishes, Condiments, and Breads:

- Brotkorb: the bread basket containing selections of the day's baking, accompanied by butter, local honey, and a spread or jam.
- Spätzle: Pronounced "SH-PAY-tz-lay", the ubiquitous egg noodle simmered in butter garnished with parsley.
- Pommes: Pronounced "POH-muss", some call them Freedom Fries, some call them Friedhelm Fries. Thinly-cut fried potatoes usually served with our house-made farm-style ketchup (or house-made farm-style mayonaise...or house-made farm-style mustard... or...).

- Ampersand Cola is a custom-made cola soft drink made from real Kola nut and Pure Cane Sugar. Other flavors also available include orange, citrus, and "Mischung" a popular mixture of all of the flavors.
- Ampersand Coffee (Iced or Hot): a proprietary-blend of coffee beans steamed with just a suggestion of traditional German spices for an exemplary, highly-caffeinated, delicately flavored coffee drink.
